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Lawyers Clearinghouse	The Lawyers Clearinghouse is a non-profit organization that sponsors three kinds of free legal services. LC hosts a CORI Clinic virtually twice a month to provide individuals with criminal records with a free analysis of their eligibility for sealing or expungement of the record. If eligible, an attorney will handle the case to completion. If not eligible, the attorney will provide the individual with an understanding of the rules and a date certain to return to the clinic when the record will become eligible for sealing or expungement. LC does not provide legal representation for open criminal cases. In addition, Lawyers Clearinghouse hosts a free legal clinic in numerous shelters for unhoused individuals in the Boston area for civil legal issues. LC also provides free legal services and educational programs to non-profits.
