Resume Writing (2 Hours) - Participants in this workshop will learn tips and best practices for writing an effective résumé.

Pre-Requisite: Must have attended the Career Center Seminar.

The Interview (1.5 Hours) – Participants in this workshop will learn tips and best practices for successful interviewing.

Pre-Requisite: Must have attended the Career Center Seminar.

Exploring Your Occupational Options (2 Hours) - This workshop provides technical instruction & hands-on exercises using on-line tools to explore & research labor market information relevant to job/career interests. Participants will:

- Review & discuss a 5 step model to assist with decision making process.
- Complete a short self-assessment to identify occupations interest type.
- Research labor market information for a given occupation.
- Discover additional tools & resources for further exploration and research

Pre-Requisites: To participate in this event, you must have:

Job Corps – free residential career training and education program for low-income adults ages 16 through 24

Department of Transitional Assistance – for low-income individuals and families to meet their basic needs, improve their quality of life, and achieve long term economic self-sufficiency.

Worcester Public Schools - offers two different adult education programs:

- → Adult Learning Center English as a Second Language instruction, along with programs to support those age 16 and older to receive their high school equivalency degree, either a HiSET or GED.
- → <u>Night Life</u>: career technical education/workforce development programs in various trades (i.e. automotive, plumbing, construction)

Bounce Information Session – provides information about the Bounce ProgramTM which is a work-readiness training program unlike any other.
