What is the Restaurant Meals Program?

The Restaurant Meals Program (RMP) allows qualified SNAP participants to order healthy meals from select restaurants and food trucks across Massachusetts. By expanding access to fresh meals, RMP helps keep Massachusetts healthy and thriving. And it supports local businesses.

Who can use RMP?

If you're eligible for SNAP and are:

- An older adult (60+), or
- A person with a disability, or
- An individual or family that is experiencing homelessness.
