ADULT BASIC SKILLS & GED/HiSET PREPARATION

Adult Basic Education classes prepare students with 21st century basic academic skills necessary to get a job, get a better job, and/or earn a HiSET (High School Equivalency Test) or GED (General Education Diploma).

Students achieve this through advancing their reading, writing, and math skills as well as building science and social studies knowledge.

A personalized advising component will equip students, through partnerships with teachers and advisors, in targeting personal, academic, and life goals by expanding core academic skills in a real-life context.

Introduction to Machine Shop/ Manufacturing Technology

MassSTEP provides a unique opportunity for adult basic education students to dually achieve high school equivalency while focusing on machining and advanced manufacturing vocational skills that prepare students for immediate job placement through internships, community partnerships, and experiential on-the-job learning.

This 22 week, 2 night per week course prepares adult students for the field of Advanced Manufacturing by introducing them to the fundamentals of machining. Students spend one night in the classroom and one night in the shop working on machines each week. Over 150 companies in Massachusetts are ready to hire students who successfully pass the certification test.
