DOL - Vets Program

A nation-wide program sponsored by the United States Department of Labor. The Department funds Veterans Employment programs in all 50 states. Massachusetts currently has Vet Reps deployed throughout the state to assist you with your employment needs.

Priority of Service

Massachusetts Proudly Serves Those Who Served by providing Priority of Services (POS) to Veterans.

US Military Veterans and covered persons receive POS over all non-covered person in all employment, training, and placement services in any workforce preparation program funded by the Department of Labor.

POS Covered persons also include spouses of veterans who have died of a service connected disability, have a total service connected disability, is missing in action or a prisoner of war.

Job Search Guidance
